

# TOWN OF SOUTHPORT

## 2026 TRASH DISPOSAL PROGRAM

---

The Town of Southport, in partnership with Chemung County and Casella Waste, is proud to offer to Town residents a Household Trash Disposal Program. This program will be limited to the first 200 applicants who apply for permits.

This is in response to the overwhelming number of requests from our residents for the return of a trash disposal program, but in a more convenient, efficient, and less costly manner.

### THIS IS HOW IT WORKS

#### Dates of Disposal:

Tuesday, August 4<sup>th</sup> through Saturday, August 29<sup>th</sup>, 2026

If you are a Town Resident and have trash lying around your property or in your basement or shed, the Town will issue to your household a Voucher that can be used to haul one load with up to 1,000 pounds of trash, free of charge, to the Chemung County Milling Station at 1690 Lake Road in Elmira.

Beginning Monday, July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026 the Town Clerk's Office will issue Vouchers for the program. To get a Voucher a resident must go to the Town Hall, 1139 Pennsylvania Ave., and provide proof of residency. The only proof of residency that will be accepted will be a valid NYS Driver's License or a Current Utility Bill in the resident's name. If you are a property owner in the Town of Southport, proof of ownership in the form of a tax bill must be shown with the above-mentioned identification. The Town will then issue an official Voucher to that person. One Voucher will be issued per household. These vouchers will be issued 50 per each week.

Hours for Collection: 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. - Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday  
8 a.m. to 11 a.m. - Saturday

This voucher cannot be replaced if lost.

*Dumping fees for any weight over the 1000 pound-limit are the responsibility of the resident. One voucher per household and vouchers cannot be combined.*

Included with this announcement is an informational sheet further explaining the program, and what kind of items that will and will not be accepted.

**Rules and Regulations:**

- Vouchers available starting Monday, July 13<sup>TH</sup>, 2026 until gone.
- Residents must apply in person for an official Voucher at the Town Clerk's Office, Southport Town Hall, 1139 Pennsylvania Ave., Elmira, M - Thurs. 7:30 am - 4:00pm, Friday 7:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.
- Proof of residency is required.
- Only One (1) Voucher per Household. **This voucher will not be replaced if lost and vouchers cannot be combined.**
- Loads will be weighed upon entering Transfer Station, then again upon leaving. Vouchers must be submitted upon entering. **ALL LOADS MUST BE TARPED BEFORE ENTERING THE FACILITY.** All un-tarped loads will be refused.
- Dumping charges for any weight exceeding 1,000 lbs. are the responsibility of the resident.
- Vouchers only valid during authorized disposal dates, consult your voucher for date and time.

**Items that WILL be accepted:**

Broken/discarded tools

Rags/old clothing

Carpeting

Metal items

Broken/discarded toys

Small Kitchen Appliances: microwaves, toasters, coffee pots, etc. (other than those listed below)

Dry, empty paint cans-no lids - **LATEX BASED PAINT ONLY**

Small car parts

Old lawn mowers - **GAS & OIL MUST BE REMOVED.**

Broken/discarded dishes

**\*\*Scrap yards will pay per pound for metal (stoves, washers, dryers) taking them to a scrap yard is another alternative to disposal at the milling station.**

**\*\*\*THERE IS AN ADDITIONAL CHARGE FOR TIRES, FURNITURE, TV's and COMPUTERS.**

**Items that WILL be accepted as RECYCLABLES:**

Cardboard

Junk mail

Glass or plastic containers

Office paper

Metal/aluminum cans

Newspapers/magazines

Cereal boxes

**Items that WILL NOT be accepted:**

**NO LIQUIDS OF ANY KIND**

Leaves/grass - Trees, Shrubs or Branches

Gas tanks

Concrete

Paint (any forms)

**No Construction Material or Wood will be accepted**

Pesticides

Bricks

Gas cans

Waste oil

Demolition/roofing debris

Used Motor Oil

**\*\*Freon items (dehumidifiers, refrigerators, air conditioners) are accepted for a fee of \$25.00 per item. Refrigerator's doors must be removed and must be empty.**
